SUGGESTIONS for creating the Fort Circuit, including port activities in the Santos estuary, using the same route sailed by corsairs, pirates, and sailors from around the world:

1\_ visit the **Casa do Trem Bélico**, with an option for a streetcar ride to get to know the historical center of the city of Santos;

2\_ continue around the "port perimeter", which includes the **Giusfredo Santini** maritime terminal, until reaching the Ponta da Praia nautical terminal, then take a skiff to the **Santo Amaro Fortress**;

3\_ return to the marine terminal and board on a schooner, which follows the same route along the estuary toward the Customs House (where **Fort Nossa Senhora do Monte Serrat** once stood), including the port terminals and the **Itapema Fortress**, returning to the starting point;

4\_ at Ponta da Praia, visit the old **Fort Augusto**, which is now the **Fishing Museum**, the Santos Aquarium, and other tourist attractions located in Barra de Santos;

5\_ to go even "further", just take a ferry across to Guarujá and keep going towards Bertioga to visit **Fort São João** and admire the ruins of **Fort São Luís**.
