



The cliffs of the small coastal mountain range to the south of the **Ilha de Santo Amaro** protects the Barra de Santos, calming the waters of the estuary which houses the largest port in South America. At the mouth of the estuary, in a historic site of lush natural beauty, King Felipe II of Spain and Portugal (Iberian Crown: 1580-1640) commanded the construction of the rustic and exuberant walls of the **Santo Amaro Fortress** from 1583/1584, a site which today is a national historic monument and the *Guarujá Historic Museum* - heritage belonging to all of us.

At the other end of the coastal mountain range, to the east and toward the South Atlantic, is **Fort Andradas**, which was begun in 1942 on the eve of Brazil's participation in World War II.
