

18th Century

1734 – Construction of Fort Augusto, occupied today by the Fishing Museum, Ponta da Praia.

1734 – Construction of the Casa do Trem Bélico, near Outeiro de Santa Catarina.

1738 – Construction of the Vera Cruz de Itapema Fortress.

1770 – Construction of Fort São Luiz substitutes Fort São Felipe.

Port of Sugar, again

1792- Construction of the Lorena Trail to discharge sugar from the Highlands

Port of Coffee

1795- First coffee exportation to Lisbon. Berths: Bispo Port at the current Largo Marques de Monte Alegre. Porto do Consulado at the current Rua Frei Gaspar.

Port of Death

Proliferation of yellow fever, small pox, bubonic plague, tetanus and tuberculosis.

19th Century

1870 – First official act to promote improvement of the Port of Santos.

1882 - Cândido Graffee Guinle, Eduardo Palacin Guinle and others assume the Port of Santos.

1889 – The Port of Santos Improvement Works Company was constituted.

1891 - The first stone of the wharf was laid where the current warehouses IV and V are.

1982– Creation of the Santos Docks Company and the first 260 meters of the wharf were inaugurated. Berthing of the Nasmith ship under the English flag.

20th Century City Port became indivisible.

1902 – Construction of the Itaipu Fortress to substitute the Santo Amaro Fortress. **Red Port**

1908 – General port workers strike, local and national.

1942 - Construction of Fort Andradas last fort built in Brazil

1968 - Start of the container movement

Port of Everything

1980 - Creation of the São Paulo State Docks Company - CODESP.

1993_ Brazilian Ports Modernization Law (Law 8.630/93)

1996 - Inauguração do monumento ao trabalhador portuário (Escultura de Vito D’Alissio e Juvenal Irene).
